Promotion of the **use a local complementary currency to co-produce the delivery of social aid** by community social services in the Tres Barrios-Amate district of the city of Seville through the development of technological & social models previously tested in different places.

- ★ **1** Action Plan: A revised strategy for rolling out Seville's local currency, aimed at addressing previous challenges and streamlining implementation. + Legal Clarity: **1** Comprehensive Legal Feasibility Study.
- + Tech Innovation: **1** Advanced Digital System for Local Currencies, with multiple replications.
- + Unified Effort: **1** Agreement with Seville Municipality. + Economic Blueprint: Business Plan for Sustainability & Growth. + Community First: Strengthened Ties with Local Shops & SSE Actors.

- + Local Shops & Businesses: Insights for economic strengthening through community currency.
- + SSE Actors & Organizers: Forged partnerships for future collaborative economic models.
- + Cerro-Amate Residents: Identified needs, setting stage for accessible social benefits.
- + Municipality & Policymakers: Learned about implementing innovative social policies.
- + Tech Sector: Developed a blueprint for supporting local currencies digitally.
- + Broader Community: Experiment laid groundwork for resilience and economic solidarity.

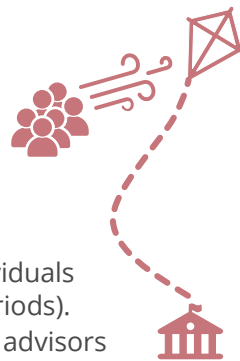


Experimental practical co-production action:



Objective

Co-production and cooperation between employment services, social services, SSE actors, private and public services to implement a local action plan to **support people excluded from the labour market** in Paggaio.



- + Integrating vulnerable groups into the labour market & the local economy (individuals nearing pension age, people with disabilities (PWD), unemployed for extended periods).
- + Personalized assistance & support from Community Centre of Paggaio & labour advisors from Development and Workforce Agency (DYPA).
- + Innovative testing of a Digital Social Wallet system.
- + MedTOWN approach incorporate as impactful practice in the new Paggaio Municipal Operation Programme 2024-2028 (under development).



23 beneficiaries with new full-time jobs. (35% women; 4,4% PWD)

600 beneficiaries including PWD, minimum guaranteed income recipients (KEA/EEE) & NEETs (young people not in employment, education or training)

Experimental practical co-production action:

Objective

Co-production of social business opportunities for people at risk of exclusion, providing training, coaching & empowerment for women, refugees & people with disabilities (PWD) at the **Social Business incubator at Al Koura**.

★ **20** business ideas developed, from community-based organizations (CBOs) & social enterprise (SSE) entities. Support of **10** youth-led start-ups, established by trained beneficiaries, that generated **11** jobs (including **2** full-time positions).

Over **140** participants representing **18** different stakeholders from Koura & Mazar actively engaged in project activities. **12** discussion sessions. + recommendations & suggestions to improve regulations & legislation including SSE & coproduction concepts & model.

 **100** beneficiaries trained (**88%** women), including **31** refugees, and **12** PWD. **20** of them benefited from business development advisory services. **74** women entrepreneurs supported; **57** of them with general capacity-building training, & **3** have accessed loans from various sources.

Experimental practical co-production action:

Objective

Promotion of an **innovative collaborative circular economy system for waste separation, reuse, & marketing** involving the community, local organisations, & Beitillu village council, including the development of a digital system to facilitate waste management and quantification into incentives or rewards at the village council to encourage participation and sustainability.

-  **1** compactor truck for the collection & transfer of organic waste; **200** waste bins. **10** new jobs; **100** individuals trained. **2** awareness campaigns (1 community, 1 national).
- + Implementation of a Digital Collection System. + Improvement in financial performance of Beitillu Village Council + improving its capacity for partnerships with the private sector. + Revenue Stream for Agricultural Cooperative.

 **650** participants (over **100** households), including **95** women, **140** youth & **265** children **12500** beneficiaries (**4500** in Beitillu & around **8000** in the surrounding communities of Deir Ammar, Jammala, & Deir Ammar refugee camp).

In the Bela Flor neighbourhood, Campolide district in Lisbon, co-production of the Junta de Freguesia & local entities for **the management of communal gardens & the recovery of degraded green plots**, collaborating with the community and promoting active individual and collective participation through **the use of time banks**.

- 1 Community Group. 1 local time bank connected to a network. 1 Community room.
- + Appropriation, Recovery & Revitalisation by the community of an unused unproductive public space.
- + Produce healthy & sustainable food, new shared knowledge & environmentally resilient behaviours.

1200 beneficiaries. More than **70%** women & children. (estimated).

400 direct beneficiaries & participants: **210** People helping, attending & benefiting from the Agroforest; **40** involved & using the time bank + in the process; **150** participants in the Community Group & Community Room. + **800** Indirect Local beneficiaries.

Use of a public space for the **creation of the Female Force Studio cluster**, to empower women entrepreneurs & women cooperatives through an intensive acceleration programme, in the Medina of Tunis.

+ Creation of the Female Force Cluster in the Medina of Tunis. + Support to female entrepreneurs and workers. + Celebrated the Lingare Festival 'celebrating access to public places'.

450 visitors to Lingare Festival within the span of one day, featuring **17** social innovation initiatives, including **2** women-led cooperatives and **15** social entrepreneurs, with a majority of female entrepreneurs.

Support to **30** women part of cooperatives and collectives, **19** socially innovative female entrepreneurs, & **105** young people, from the Grand Tunis region; **30** young people from Mahdia & Kairouan regions; **50** Actors from the public, private and CSO sectors.
